

## East Sac Little League 2010 Registration

Early and regular registration for the 2010 season is now closed. Late registration is available until the last tryout session in January.

### Instructions:

1. Make one copy of the player's birth certificate. Make sure it does not read "abstract".
2. Complete the Player Application (one per player). Make sure you include a current, legible email address and phone number. Please make sure to check the box for baseball (includes T ball) or softball.
3. Complete the Medical Release form (one per player).
4. Make one copy of **three** "proof of residency". In other words, one copy of your driver's license, one copy of a utility bill and one copy of your auto insurance policy. Please do not submit 3 copies of your driver's license, etc. Please review the document titled "Residence Eligibility Requirements". Only 1 utility bill is allowed. Do not submit a SMUD and PG&E bill. Whichever 3 documents you chose to provide, the address on the document must be within the East Sac Little League boundary.
5. Make check payable to East Sac Little League for the total amount of registration fees.
6. A snack bar deposit is required for every player. Please make one check payable to East Sac Little League (the amount is \$50) for each player registered. For example, if you are registering 3 players you will need to submit 3 deposit checks. **Deposit checks are destroyed when you complete the required one snack bar shift per player during the season. On the memo line of the check write the player's name, your name and your cell phone number. This will allow the snack bar coordinator to properly reconcile deposit checks.**
7. If you would like to submit additional information about your player, you may submit a separate sheet attached to the application. Useful information is team and division played the prior year and desired division for the upcoming season. For example, "My son played AA last year for the Bobcats and he would like to move up to AAA this year".

For completed applications submitted after December 12, 2009, the following fees will apply:

T Ball: \$105

Baseball: \$115

Softball: \$115
